

Kiah Church Update On 4 January 2020 Our Lady of the Princess Highway Church at Kiah and the adjacent Kiah Community Hall were totally destroyed by fire. The Church (\$356,000) and Contents (\$15,500) were insured by Catholic Church Insurance on behalf of our Parish. The cost of debris removal is also covered by insurance. The Kiah Community have expressed a very strong interest in purchasing the land and re-siting their Community Hall on that land. The BVSC, who had insurance or the Community Hall, support the Kiah Community's wish to rebuild on the Church land. Kiah Community representatives are talking to potential benefactors to assist with the purchase of the land. The Parish Finance Committee has agreed to provide the Kiah Community with price guidance on the sale price of the land and also to offer a free 3 month first option to the Kiah Community to seek funding and make an offer to the Parish. In time, the Parish Finance Committee intends to reinvest the insurance proceeds and Kiah land sale proceeds into a property asset that will generate an income stream to support the long term viability of the Parish.

Our mission as the Christian community of St. Peter's Parish, enlightened and inspired by the Holy Spirit, is to be salt and light through the loving way of our words, actions and respect for the dignity of all so that others may experience the love of Christ.


