ADVENT SPECIAL - MANTRA MEDITATION

A mantra is a single word or short phrase that the person repeats throughout the meditation period. Mantra is a Sanskrit word, now a recognised English word; it means 'that which clears the mind.' The mantra helps us clear our mind of distractions. The result is increased focus and attention on God within. You can choose any mantra for your meditation, for example Abba, Jesus. The ancient Christian prayer word 'Maranatha' (Come Lord) is ideally suited as a mantra. It is recommended to choose one mantra only and not change it. In this way the mantra can become rooted in the heart; it eventually becomes spiritually part of us.

Steps...

- 1. Adjust your seat height and angle so that your back is relatively straight, and also relaxed, very comfortably. Just let the breath flow naturally in and out of the body, and let your gut move freely with the breathing. Let your spine move with your breathing, so that you can be sure you're not holding yourself rigidly.
- 2. Make sure that your hands are supported so that there's no strain in your shoulders or between the shoulder-blades. Relax your shoulders, letting them roll back to open your chest. Let your shoulders move with your breathing.
- 3. Take a few deep breaths. Adjust the angle of your head, so that the back of your neck is relaxed.
- 4. Close your eyes gently and relax your jaw, your tongue, your eyes, and your brow.
- 5. Let go all kinds of thoughts, good or bad, and all the distractions.
- 6. Begin to recite your mantra inside
- 7. Listen to your mantra in the depth of your heart.
