### RCIA

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is a formal program of catechetical instruction, prayer and spirituality, and liturgies whereby adults — calls catechumens — are formally admitted into the Catholic Church and receive the Sacraments of Initiation — Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist.

The process takes place over an extended period of time culminating at Pentecost with the reception of the Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil.

It is held every Tuesdays (4pm -5pm) from Advent through to Pentecost. The first information gathering will be on Tuesday **1<sup>st</sup> December** at 4pm at the parish Centre (36 Verner Street). **Welcome**
