The **Transfiguration** experience is a bit like a dance. We are drawn in to encounter the other and then step out to keep moving the dance around the floor. Elijah and Moses both encountered the Living God and were sent out to make God present. Jesus' disciples encountered God in Jesus. They too were sent out. Moses, Elijah and Jesus' disciples meet God in both their weakness and their strength. Encountering God was not a one event wonder. We keep meeting God in prayer and going out in Mission over and over again. Both the encounter and the stepping out are part of the creative tension that moves the dance of life around.
