Matthew 25:13

Jesus often refers to Himself as *the Bread of life*, to which many respond, “This saying is hard; who can accept it?” And it is hard. It is not always easy for us to see God in the Eucharist. Our senses often ‘fool us’. But this is where our *faith* has such value. Whereas our knowledge of doctrine gets us so far, our faith must take us the rest of the way. Do we trust in Christ’s words? This **is** my Body.

The greatness of God’s love for us is in the **Eucharist** – where He remains neither distant nor overbearing. Instead, in the Eucharist, He identifies with us to the point that He bears our sins – not bearing with us, but bearing us up. He asks us to have a role in our own salvation, to freely choose Him, as He transforms the “fruit and work” (the bread) of our own human hands into His own Body and Blood.

As our children now receive Christ for the first time. Let us be reminded and never cease to be amazed at the Gift God is giving us. We have touched God – and in

faith our lives cannot now be left unchanged. *Happy are those who have not seen me and yet believe* (John 20:29). And yet, the paradox is, we *have* seen Jesus, God Himself. And not only have we seen Him; He has entered our very bodies. Fr Trenton
