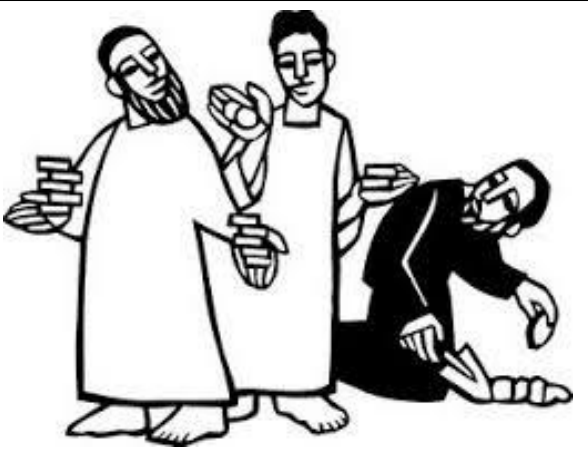

In the Gospel today, when the Master returns, he finds that the first two servants he gave money to have doubled their share. Both are rightly rewarded. But the third servant has ‘selfishly’, only attempted to preserve what was given to him, afraid that he would lose it. Yet ironically in the end, lose it he did, and strangely enough he loses it all because of his erroneous attempt to preserve it.

In the same way God’s Mercy, and more so Christian love itself, while always coming to us from God, is not something that can remain with us as its *terminus*. Indeed by its very definition it is that which is passed on, which continually

‘gives’ – this is what Mercy, and certainly love, is. It can not and does not sit stagnant, and if it does, it simply ceases to be.

The one thing you cannot do with the divine Mercy is hang onto it as your own possession. But rather for it to grow and remain in you, you must spend it lavishly. If not, the Master will not so much take it from you, so much as it will vanish! The one who has received God’s Mercy however, and knows what to do with it will be given more. This isn’t God being vindictive, it’s simply spiritual physics. With every prayer, Fr Trenton
