2020 Plenary Council: This weekend marks the launch of the formal preparation in the Australian Catholic Church for the 2020 Plenary Council. The last time the Australian Church held a Plenary Council was 1937. Since our last gathering, much has changed in our Country and World. Pope Francis has spoken of the need to engage in the world and respond in Truth and faith. The journey toward the Plenary Council will help us to prepare to listen to God by listening to one another. We invite all people to be a part of the listening and dialogue encounter in the next two years. It is a very significant moment for the Church in Australia to make decisions about the future.
