**Plenary Council 2020** – A Plenary Council is a formal meeting of bishops and other representatives of the Church in a certain region (in our case, Australia). Its purpose is to discern what God is asking of His Church at a present time. It has the authority to make church laws on the results of its discernment, and while in accord with the very nature of the Church, the bishops will vote on future directions, they will do so by listening to the Holy Spirit speaking through the faithful. The bishops, guided by the Holy Spirit, faithfully interpret, protect and apply what God has revealed and is revealing. That access comes through a special gift that all the baptised received at baptism when they were anointed. It is called “a sense for the faith” (*sensus fidelis*). The whole church *together* has this gift, the *sensus fidelium*. No *individual* has an infallible sense of the faith. We only have a sense of what God is saying by listening *together* as Christ’s Body. We now begin to “listen to what the Spirit is saying to the churches”; the instruction to the seven churches of Asia Minor in the Book of Revelation. From that time Christians have met to listen to the Spirit at times of important decisions. We are called to do so again.
