Plenary Council 2020 - Until now, many had never heard of a Plenary Council, which isn't surprising, since the last one was held in 1937 – before many of us were born! The main reason why they are so rare is that the Second Vatican Council gave rise to bishop's conferences, in which the bishops alone, as Successors of the Apostles, gather periodically to consider matters and make decisions on them. This of course, is their ordained role and threefold munera in the Church, to teach and guard the deposit of faith, to sanctify through the Sacraments, and to govern God's Church on earth, entrusted to their leadership and care as its pastors. Now the question becomes... 'If the bishops' conference can already discuss and legislate on these matters, why have a Plenary Council?' The obvious answer is that in the bishops conference only the bishops take part, whereas in a Plenary Council others also participate. While the Bishops by the Church's very nature, always make the decisions as the head of the Body, it is the members which make up that Body who authentically and sensitively indicate to the head what needs to be addressed and acted upon. This is the beauty of the Church as Christ's Living Body. For this beautiful and necessary reason the bishops have indicated, that there is to be process of preparation for the Plenary Council in which all Catholics are invited to play their part. All observations will be gathered before the Council meets in 2020. It is an important opportunity for all the baptised to contribute as members of His Glorious but wounded body, the Church. As we prepare for this moment let us, with great confidence, listen to Christ living in us, and speaking through the grace of the Holy Spirit. The question being asked is: What is God asking of us in Australia at this time?' It is a mature question which assumes great reflection prior to our responding. Note that God is the one we must focus on... what is God asking of His Church? Not isolated groups or individuals... but God. And God speaks through His whole Body. So let us have the courage to speak His word. Reflections can be submitted through opportunities such as the parish survey and also directly online at the website of the Council: plenarycouncil.catholic.org.au. Let us Keep our Eyes only ever on Christ, lest we stray.
