World Day of the Poor - Sharing a Sunday Meal

Date: Nov 18 2018. The Pope's Message for World Day of the Poor contains one very practical suggestion: the sharing of the Sunday meal with the poor. Equivalent **Pope Francis said:** "*On this World Day we are invited to give concreteness to the words of the Psalm: «The afflicted shall eat and be satisfied» (Psalm 22:27). Praying together as a community and sharing a Sunday meal is an experience which takes us back to the earliest Christian community, described by St. Luke the Evangelist with all his originality and simplicity: «And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. [...] And all who believed were together and had all things in common; and they sold their possessions and goods and distributed them to all, as any had need» (Acts 2:42.44-45)".*
