# THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT YEAR A 11<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER 2022

GOD'S KINGDOM IS NEAR. JOHN THE BAPTIST URGED THE PEOPLE TO PREPARE FOR THE COMING OF THE KINGDOM BY REPENTING OF THEIR SINS. THEIR BAPTISM BY JOHN IN THE JORDAN RIVER WAS AN IMPORTANT RITUAL ACT OF SORROW. BUT THEY ALSO HAD TO EXPRESS THEIR SORROW BY REFORMING THEIR LIVES. THE SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION, AND RIGHT LIVING, ARE EXCELLENT MEANS THROUGH WHICH WE CAN PREPARE FOR THE FEAST OF CHRISTMAS.

**Advent** – The third Sunday in Advent (Advent III) shifts from a tone of expectation of Christ's coming to one of rejoicing at the arrival of God's kingdom with the coming of Jesus. On this third Sunday of Advent, we light one more candle on our wreath: the pink candle that represents joy.

Dear Lord, With each of these candles that is lighted, may we rekindle within ourselves the desire to prepare a way for the birth of Christ. With each new candle that is lighted, may the flame of Christ's coming grow brighter and brighter so that this Christmas may see a fresh and ever-green coming of the Lord of Light into each of our hearts and into our whole world. Amen
