Tap & Go Machine – A Tap & Go machine has been placed in our church. It is located at the back of the Church. Each payment made through Tap & Go is split between 1st Collection (Clergy) and 2nd Collection (Parish). This cannot be used for Planned Giving contributions. To use: ● Use your credit card ● Tap the machine ● One payment for Parish & Clergy ● A fixed amount is deducted (currently \$10) with each Tap ● Tap multiple times till reaching the amount you wish to donate ● 30% of your payment will go to Clergy (1st Collection) and 70% to Parish (2nd Collection).
