Archdiocesan COVID-19 Protocols Effective Monday 28th June 2021 Masses, Weddings, Liturgies, Gatherings – Masks are mandatory for those 12 years + Priest (when celebrating Liturgy) and Lectors (when proclaiming the Word) can dispense with the mask

Priest and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion must wear masks when distributing the Sacred Host

No congregational singing, but a cantor (x4) can sing if 4m2 from congregation Holy Communion only under the species of bread

Holy Communion to be received only in the hand

No touching at the sign of peace

Collection bags not to be passed around, but can be placed on an extended stick to allow collection of cash by a few parishioners

Apply the 4m² rule to all liturgies and gatherings (except funerals).

Funerals – Restricted to 100 persons.

Other Matters – Service NSW App is mandatory

Physical roster is reasonable for those who are unable to use the App (keep for 30 days) Availability of hand sanitiser is essential

Families can sit together, but in relation to other persons/families apply 4m² rule.

Sacrament of First Eucharist – Important Dates – Parent Formation Night Thursday 2nd September at 7pm in St Joseph's Hall. Rite of Enrolment at Mass – Saturday 4th September at 10am Mass or Sunday 12th September at 6pm Mass. Retreat Day – Wednesday 3rd November, 9.10am to 3.20pm in St Joseph's Hall. Sacrament of First Eucharist, Thursday 4th November at 6pm in Sacred Heart Church.

National Day of Prayer – is Sunday 22nd August. There will be an online gathering offering prayers and reflections at various times during the day. Flyers are at the back of the church.

Vocations – Vocations to the Priesthood and Religious life are a top priority for the further evangelisation in the Archdiocese of Canberra and Goulburn in the many years ahead. Tap & Go Machine – A Tap & Go machine has been placed in our church. It is located at the back of the Church. Each payment made through Tap & Go is split between 1st Collection (Clergy) and 2nd Collection (Parish). This cannot be used for Planned Giving contributions. To use: • Use your credit card • Tap the machine • One payment for Parish & Clergy • A fixed amount is deducted (currently \$10) with each Tap • Tap multiple times till reaching the amount you wish to donate • 30% of your payment will go to Clergy (1st Collection) and 70% to Parish (2nd Collection).
