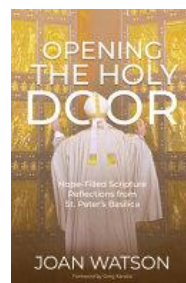
THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD YEAR C 2ND FEBRUARY 2025
