**Euthanasia in the ACT** - As a result of legislation passed late last year, the ACT can now make laws on Euthanasia/Voluntary Assisted Dying (VAD). Consultation on the legislation has begun with a vote on the issue likely to be held at the end of 2023 or the start of 2024. It is essential to understand why the Catholic Church opposes Euthanasia and why we need to care for the most vulnerable and to protect life. Archbishop Christopher Prowse summarises Catholic moral teaching on Euthanasia and provides pastoral guidance in a document, copies of which are available at the back of the church.

Aid to the Church in Need - The Catholic Charity *Aid to the Church in Need* has launched their "Nigeria: Young. Faithful. Crucified" global campaign. Did you know that in 2022 a total of 5,014 Christians were killed for their faith in Nigeria?
