First Collection - The 'First Collection' is for the parish priest. Second Collection - The 'Second Collection' (Parish Planned Giving) is for the maintenance and day to day running of our parish. If you would like to contribute electronically to the 'Second Collection' (Parish Planned Giving) then you can deposit directly into the Sacred Heart Parish Temora account, Catholic Archdiocese of Canberra & Goulburn. **Remember to include your Name and Ref No: 140s11.1. BSB: 062 786 No: 000015031 Sacred Heart Parish Temora.** We also have **collection boxes** (one for the First Collection and one for the Second Collection) on the offertory table in the middle of the church and on the table at the back of the church where you can place money/envelopes.

Tap & Go Machine – A Tap & Go machine has been placed in our church. It is located at the back of the Church. Each payment made through Tap & Go is split between 1st Collection (Clergy) and 2nd Collection (Parish). This cannot be used for Planned Giving contributions. To use: • Use your credit card • Tap the machine • One payment for Parish & Clergy • A fixed amount is deducted (currently \$10) with each Tap • Tap multiple times till reaching the amount you wish to donate • 30% of your payment will go to Clergy (1st Collection) and 70% to Parish (2nd Collection).

First Collection for Sunday 19th September 2021 **\$380.80**. Second Collection for Sunday 19th September 2021 **\$1,002.05**.
