**Tap & Go Machine** – A Tap & Go machine has been placed in our church. It is located at the back of the Church. Each payment made through Tap & Go is split between 1st Collection (Clergy) and 2nd Collection (Parish). This cannot be used for Planned Giving contributions. To use: • Use your credit card • Tap the machine • One payment for Parish & Clergy • A fixed amount is deducted (currently \$10) with each Tap • Tap multiple times till reaching the amount you wish to donate • 30% of your payment will go to Clergy (1st Collection) and 70% to Parish (2nd Collection).
