# THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD YEAR C 1<sup>ST</sup> JUNE 2025

THE LORD WILL RETURN. THE ASCENSION OF JESUS, WHEREBY HE IS GLORIFIED AT THE FATHER'S RIGHT HAND AND MADE 'RULER OF EVERYTHING', DOES NOT SIGNAL HIS DEPARTURE FROM OUR MIDST. IT POINTS RATHER TO A NEW MODE OF PRESENCE THAT WILL ENDURE 'UNTIL THE END OF THE WORLD.' IN THE MEANTIME, IT IS OUR VOCATION, AS HIS CHURCH, TO REVEAL HIM.

#### Reflection by Nick Brodie, Dean of Academic Studies, Jane Franklin Hall, Hobart

'Jesus is not abandoning the disciples', Pope Francis points out. 'He ascends to Heaven, but he does not leave them alone.'

Jesus' Ascension, Francis suggests, can be understood with respect to two aspects of the event. Firstly, Jesus 'announces the gift of the Spirit.' Then, secondly, Jesus 'blesses the disciples.'

In sending the Spirit, Jesus ensures that he remains present with his disciples in a new way. There is now, Francis explains, 'a presence that does not want to limit our freedom.' Jesus leaves room for us to make our own way, through time and space, accompanied by the Spirit. As Francis guips, it is the case that 'true love makes us protagonists.'

We are now 'his witnesses in the world', he reminds us. By blessing his followers, Jesus shows that he 'is the great priest of our life.' Ascending to the Father, he intercedes for us and goes 'to present our humanity to him.'

Francis therefore encourages us to reflect on how truly we embrace our call 'to be witnesses to the Gospel.' Are we 'capable of loving others, leaving them free and making room for them'? Do we intercede on their behalf 'and bless their lives'? Do we really trust that Jesus wants to work through us?
