Pentecost Sunday - Pentecost Sunday 2025, celebrated on 8th June, marks one of the most important feasts in the Church's liturgical year. Occurring fifty days after Easter Sunday, Pentecost commemorates the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles and the Blessed Virgin Mary, empowering them, as Jesus promised he would, to preach the gospel to the whole world (Acts 2; see Acts 1:4-8). Often called the "birthday of the Church," this day is a wondrous reminder of how Jesus fully equips his Church to carry out her Great Commission to "make disciples all nations" (Matt. 28:18-20; see Isa. 49:6, 22).
