**New Smart Terminal** – Our Tap and Go Machine has been replaced with a new Smart Terminal at the back of the church. Payments are made the same way as you do on the Tap and Go Machine except that now there are four payment options - \$5, \$10, \$20 or you can choose your own amount. Payments are distributed using the same process as the Tap and Go Machine – 30% of your payment will go to Clergy (1<sup>st</sup> collection) and 70% to our Parish (2<sup>nd</sup> collection). **Movie Night Fundraiser** – The parish is holding its Movie Night Fundraiser on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> May at the Temora Town Hall Cinema from 6pm with the movie 'One Life' to start at 7pm.
