**EVERY PART OF THE MASS IS SIGNIFICANT:** the Word of God has equal weighting with receiving the Body and Blood of Jesus in the Eucharist. We must be present to hear God speaking to us through His Word in the readings from the scriptures. This is an essential part for our presence at Mass. It is not just a matter of hearing with our ears, but rather one of receiving in our hearts the seed of the Divine Word and then allowing it to bear fruit within our lives. Those who read the Word at Mass should make themselves familiar with the readings prior to Mass. This is necessary if they are really to proclaim the Word of God and not merely read it as you would a book. Parishioners who are present should in turn listen with open hearts and minds and be conscious that it is God himself who is speaking to them. It is further required that to fulfil our obligation that we continue to be present until the presider gives the final blessing and then exits the Church. This shows total reverence for the One we have come to worship.
