A MIXED BAG

Herod was an interesting character. On the one hand, he was attracted to the person and message of John the Baptist. On the other hand, he was full of his own importance, and more so at a (bawdy) banquet with his colleagues. Of course, there are similarities between Herod and ourselves: responding to the movement of the Spirit on the one hand, yet contrary to our better judgement prone to self-indulgence on the other. The latter can take many and varied forms. We each pick our own poison. Problem is we can think that until I get 'my act' together, God is not interested. After a while we can think why bother. I will never be 'good enough'. Correct. You will never be good enough. But that is not the point. The point is to let God encounter you where you are. As in the Gospels, where Jesus met people where they were, so too for each of us. Fr James Martin SJ puts it thus (emphasis added): "If God meets you where you are, then where you are is a place to meet God. You don't have to wait until your life settles down, or the kids move out of the house, or you've found that perfect apartment, or you recover from that long illness. You don't have to wait until you have overcome your sinful patterns, or you're more "religious" or you can pray "better." You don't have to wait for any of that. Because God is ready now."
