HOLY TRINITY = UNITY IN DIVERSITY

On 24 March 1974, fifty years ago, Holy Trinity Church was opened with a reported 1200 in attendance (see 'The Early Years of Holy Trinity Parish', Brian Carr in 'Curtin Turns 50, The Story of a Canberra Suburb, 1964-2015'. Copies are available at the exits). The efforts of many saw their hopes for a parish church realised. If we could take a drone or birds eye view above the church, we would see that the design consists of three triangles making the one beautiful edifice to the glory of God and the sanctification of all who gather therein. The unity in diversity of the design reflects the doctrine of the Trinity; one yet three, Father, Son and Holy Spirit – each is God yet God is one. We understand that God is a community of persons by virtue of how God has self-revealed in the story of salvation. "The doctrine of the Trinity is not then, an arid theological puzzle but a necessary conclusion from a sense of being grasped by and held within divide communion" (Brendan Byrne). While the formulation of the doctrine of the Trinity occurred well after the New Testament era, today's readings afford background to that developed understanding. Thus our Old

Testament Reading from the Book of Deuteronomy affirms Israel as chosen and rescued by God. Our Second Reading from St Paul to the people of Ephesus speaks of the intimacy Jesus had with God. He addressed God as "Abba" or the familiar Aramaic term for "Dad". The same intimacy is ours too by virtue of our baptism and status as sons and daughters of God and co-heirs. "The upshot is banishment of the fear that would be associated with a servile relationship to God and the gaining of the confidence and freedom that comes from a sense of being "one of the family"" (ibid). The explicit Trinitarian note in the great commission of the Gospel, that is, to baptise "in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit" is so that all might come to share in the gift of intimate communion. Many young families gathered for the opening of Holy Trinity Church. A relative few of those individuals are still in the parish, many have moved away and many others have died. Our lives change but the love of God is constant. So too the call to share that love of God is constant. For most of the baptised, this is the call of the lay apostolate, that is to make known the love of God in the witness of our lives. Over this weekend, men will gather at South Woden Parish for a time of prayer and reflection so as to better live that call. We pray for them. So too we consider the possibility of enriching our faith community by commitment to a ministry vital to parish life (see attached). To do so is to build on the commitment and legacy of parishioners over the past fifty years. In this Archdiocesan Year of the Holy, we pray that the Holy Spirit would kindle in us the fire of God's love so that God might be "all in all" (1 Cr 15:28).
