- 1. For Pope Francis, chief shepherd of the flock, and all who are pastors in Jesus' name, that they will care for those entrusted to them with lifegiving love. (Pause for silent prayer) Let us pray to the Lord.
- 2. For an openness in this month of May to Mary, Mother of God and 'first disciple', that we might seek her intercession on our pilgrim way. (Pause for silent prayer) Let us pray to the Lord.
- **3.** For citizens everywhere, that they will emerge from the coronavirus pandemic with a new awareness of and commitment to our shared humanity. (Pause for silent prayer) Let us pray to the Lord.
- 4. For ourselves, that we would foster a sense of vocation by listening for and responding to the call of the Good Shepherd in our prayer, in our relationships and in the events of our communities. (Pause for silent prayer) Let us pray to the Lord.
- 5. For parents, students and teachers that their collaboration will ensure engaging and productive online learning. (Pause for silent prayer) Let us pray to the Lord.
- 6. For the recently deceased, especially those who have died from the coronavirus, . . . and for those whose anniversary of death occurs around this time, that the risen Lord will shepherd them to eternal life. (Pause for silent prayer) Let us pray to the Lord.
