We pray for the Church, that the deliberations of the Synod will inspire the People of God to realise their common dignity as sisters and brothers in Christ. (Pause for silent prayer) Lord, hear us.

We pray for prison inmates, their guards and their chaplains, that today's Prison Sunday will give them common cause to advocate for reform of the penal system. (Pause for silent prayer) Lord, hear us.

We pray for those who have died recently . . . and for those whose anniversary of death occurs around this time, that they will take their place in the communion of saints and rejoice in God forever. (Pause for silent prayer) Lord, hear us.
