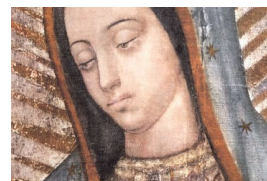

Fr Dom's Gospel Reflection:

In the First Reading, God's calling to prophesy has moved Amos so strongly that he has left his life as a shepherd, and also left his home in the southern Kingdom of Judah, to go to the northern Kingdom of Israel, to preach repentance. But why is he prophesying repentance? He is sent out to Israel, to a people who are living a life of luxury and greed, in a society that is only growing in corruption. Such was their deceit that the people in the marketplace had two sets of scales: one for buying and one for selling. The very people who needed safety in this city were unable to get in because they could not afford to bribe the officials. They lived in a time of great prosperity and comfort and were not genuine in their thanksgiving to God. Through Amos, God then threatens that it will all be taken away if they do not turn back to God. In the end, God does carry out this threat. Justice and love of neighbour complement each other and if one is lacking then so is the other. Notice in the Gospel, the apostles with their few possessions are vulnerable and need help from their own community. Keeping them at the same level as those that they are there to help, in keeping with the nature of Jesus' own life and mission.

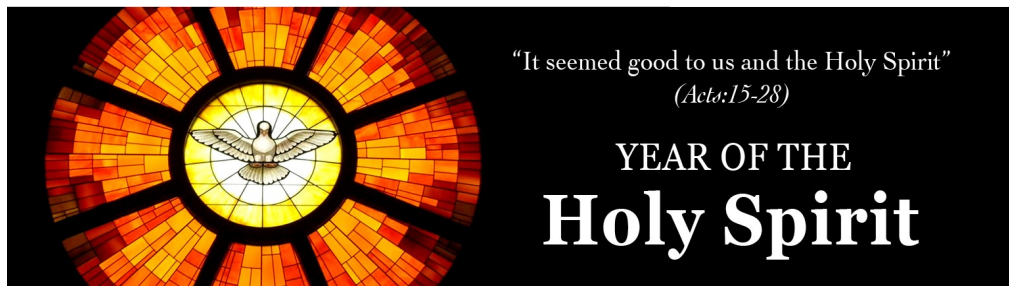

Such is the richness of the grace which he has showed on us in all wisdom and insight.

He has let us know the mystery of his purpose, the hidden plan he so kindly made in Christ from the be-

ginning to act upon when the times had run their course to the end:

that he would bring everything together under Christ, as head, everything in the heavens and everything on earth.
