Fr Dom's Gospel Message: What do you have to look forward to? It seems the media would like you to look forward to very little, perhaps that life just gets back to normal and so that you can thank God it's over. Christmas can seem like an time when we do not actually long for anything and instead just hope to get through it because it is truly a time for despair. This is can be a subtle message that the media and popular culture would have us believe. Jesus did not deal in the currency of fear, his was all about hope. Anybody that does not hope is fading truly. Hope is actually yearning for a life beyond the here and now; life yearning for more of itself; wanting to eternally unfold with the author of life.

"In Advent, the liturgy frequently repeats and assures us, as if to overcome our natural diffidence, that God 'comes': he comes to be with us in every situation of ours, he comes to dwell among us, to live with us and within us; he comes to fill the gaps that divide and separate us; he comes to reconcile us with him and with one another. He comes into human history to knock at the door of every man and every woman of good will, to bring to individuals, families and peoples the gifts of brotherhood, harmony and peace. This is why Advent is par excellence the season of hope in which believers in Christ are invited to remain in watchful and active waiting, nourished by prayer and by the effective commitment to love" (Pope Benedict XVI, 2006 Angelus).


