Message for the week

Last week, Jesus has to work with the disciples who were not able to see how Jesus could feed the five thousand and this week the people are equally blind to the food that will last. 'The food that will last,' is a direct reference to the bread that falls on the ground during the Exodus, which can only be eaten on the day it fell, though the bread that fell on the sixth day could be kept so as to eat it on the seventh day, The Sabbath day when it was forbidden to do the work of collecting it. The food that will last is that bread that goes beyond any bodily needs and allows us to fulfil what God needs from us. It lasts because God has designed it to last for our benefit and brings us to the Sabbath Day, it is spiritual food bringing us closer to God. He then tells them to work for food that will endure and nourish them so that they will receive eternal life and that this type of labour is, 'believing in the one he has sent.' Believing in Jesus who is 'the bread that comes down from heaven and gives life to the world.' Faith is that awareness that allows us to know where to go to seek that bread out. Jesus' mission is to share with us his communion with the Father, his eternal life. In the Book of Revelation, we hear, 'If you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in to you and eat with you, and you with me (3: 20).
