Divine Mercy Sunday

In 2002 Pope John Paul II said, "Peace be with you!" This is how Jesus greet his Apostles in the Gospel for this Sunday, that closes the Octave of Easter, Peace is the gift of God. The Creator himself has written the law of respect for life on the human heart: "If anyone sheds the blood of a man, by man shall his blood be shed; for in the image of God has he made man," is said in Genesis (9:6).

When the merciless logic of arms prevails everywhere, only God can redirect hearts to thoughts of peace. Only he can give the energies that are necessary to be freed from hatred and the thirsts for revenge and to undertake the process of negotiation for an agreement and for peace.
