Dear Clergy, Religious Leaders and all the lay faithful,

I write to seek your prayers for our emeritus Archbishop Francis Carroll whose health has been indifferent over the past three months and especially more recently.

At around the time of his 88th birthday in September and with his health declining, Father Francis agreed to enter residential care at the *Loretto Home of Compassion* in Wagga Wagga. Understandably, after enjoying his retirement home in Galing Place for the past 12 years, the move into care has not been an easy one for him. That said, he recognized and accepted that he was becoming frailer and that living alone without the security of around-the-clock care, was the best path for him.

For the past few weeks, Father Francis has required treatment in Wagga's Calvary Hospital and he remains in their care as I write. He is receiving very good medical attention from both doctors and nursing staff and the hope is that he will be able to return to Loretto in the near future.

With his approval, I ask that you pray for our beloved former Archbishop as he struggles to regain good health and also to seek the prayerful support of your parishioners.
