## Being ready/staying awake.

As we approach the season of Advent which is the beginning of the new Liturgical Year B, during which time the Church will focus it's attention on the Gospel of Mark, we should stay alert to the riches that are still coming to us in the Gospel of Matthew: One of them being to **STAY AWAKE**, which is the Jewish way of saying BE PREPARED FOR THE LORD'S RETURN. This Gospel is a warning to keep our stock of oil, which is our faith and enthusiasm for doing the Lord's Will, well topped up lest it run dry on the dusty road of life, especially in this spiritually arid country Australia. As we know, we are very much a Pilgrim Church and a pilgrim people. And while we tend to see the World we live in as a reality we often can't ignore, we are challenged not to emulate the unwise Virgins who failed to keep their sight on Jesus and the eventual fulfilment of His kingdom. To put it in an Australian perspective, if we ventured into the Outback without the necessary preparations should we be surprised if others are unable to save us.?

This weekend I will be in Pambula & Merimbula doing mission promotion for the Columbans. I am sorry to be leaving "the Bay" and all of you, the parishioners of St. Bernard's and Sacred Heart, Moruya because of all the warmth and friendship I have received from you. You will always have a place in my heart. Pray for me as I continue my missionary journey just as I will pray for and remember you. God bless.

## What is pastoral care?

The word *pastor* comes from the Latin word for "shepherd." A pastor is to be a shepherd or caretaker of God's flock. "Be shepherds of God's flock that is under your *care*, serving as overseers—not because you must, but because you are willing, as God wants you to be; not greedy for money, but eager to serve; not lording it over those entrusted to you, but being examples to the flock" (1 Peter 5:2-3). But there are many other works that can be done by the faithful. Generally speaking, pastoral care refers to the ministries/services usually performed by priests or deacons. Some denominations of the Christian faith use the phrase to refer to more specific aspects of a pastor's ministry, such as counselling and visitation.

Our pastoral care team consists of clergy and lay people, who are responsible for and committed to the sick and housebound as well as running a multitude of tasks associated with the sacramental life of the Church.
