This week we reflect on the story of **Ditosa – a young girl from** Mozambique who hopes to go to university and become a police officer. In 2013, Ditosa faced a challenging future with food scarcity, little education and few job prospects. Cared for by family after her parents died of AIDS-related illnesses, Ditosa and her family were supported by Project Compassion through Caritas Australia and Caritas Regional Chokwe. In 2018, Ditosa has graduated from school and is ambitious for the future. She says 'without the support of people from Australia and Caritas I would not have been given this opportunity to continue my schoolina'.
