# **2020 PLENARY COUNCIL: Phase II** Let's Listen & Discern

How is God calling us to be a Christ-centred Church that is:



May 20, 2018, the Solemnity of Pentecost, the church in Australia began the 2020 Plenary Council aimed at bringing together the people of God in Australia to listen to God by listening to one another. All were invited to listen to what the spirit is saying. This led to the Phase I of the process, with the call to listen and dialogue. At the end, Six National Themes were developed from the contributions of well over 222,000 voices across Australia. Thank you for your participation in Phase 1 of the Plenary Council Process which is such an important part of our story in the Australian Church as we respond to God's call in our lives.

We are now preparing for Phase 2 which moves from listening and dialogue into *listening* and *discernment*. This is a process of communal discernment rather than individual discernment. We look forward to our Parish Discernment Sessions in the coming months prior to Christmas, so to assist in the preparations for this you are requested to sign up for the Theme in which you are interested – the lists will be open during **September.** You can sign up for more than one Theme – the sessions are of 2 hours duration and are a process of **prayer, contemplation, sharing with each other** and seeking God's direction.
