ST BERNARD'S PARISH



With the Feast of Christ the King of the Universe, we mark the end of the Church Year. It's the end of a journey and the respite before the beginning of Advent and the preparation for Christ-

Formerly the emphasis of the Feast was on the triumph and kingly rule of Christ...often depicted even today by Processions in parishes. Since Vatican 11 the emphasis is much more on Jesus' role as Shepherd. We reflect on the King whose wealth lies in his love for all, and whose authority is exercised through the service of those who are of-

ten considered the least in society.

In Colossians we read: 'God has rescued us from the power of darkness and transferred us into the kingdom of Christ... this Christ who has been with us from the beginning of Time. . 'the firstborn of Creation'. Christ is the image of the invisible God, whose authority and power far exceeds that of any human king. There is no other force at work on earth that compares with him. Christ's Kingdom is much bigger than our minds can fathom. King of the Universe means that all peoples and all creation Belong.

The good thief on the Cross is welcomed open heartedly to this Kingdom.. 'this day you will be with me in Paradise'. Doesn't that tell us that it is how we live our lives during the week is what it is all about, not only what we believe on a Sunday? We are asked to be this revelation to those with whom we live, work and play. We are to be **Love** in this world where there is so much bitterness and division. If our little kingdoms are not in line with those of Christ, it is important that we change the way we operate and bring love and hope to all those with whom perhaps we may find it difficult to love.

This week, we might join with Pope Francis in praying to share the Church's Universal Mission, that we and all Christians might strengthen and grow God's mission through the Church by our own praver and action.
