

## THIS IS YOUR MOTHER

Under the title of Help of Christians, Mary was chosen as Patroness of Australasia by the First provincial Synod, convened by Archbishop Polding in Sydney in 1844.

This weekend the Australian Bishops call on Mary Help of Christians as they entrust the care of the nation from COVID-19. The Prayer of Entrustment included in the Bulletin is inclusive of everyone.

The Gospel of John for this Feast reveals the dying wish of Jesus that Mary is the mother of us all through that initial relationship with 'the disciple' representing us all.

Near the cross of Jesus stood his mother And his mother's sister, Mary the wife of Clopas and Mary of Magdala. Seeing his Mother and the disciple he loved standing near her, Jesus said to his mother 'Woman, this is your son'. Then to the disciple he said 'This is your mother'. And from that moment the disciple Made a place for her in his home'. (Jn 19:25-27)

Let us pray the Prayer of Entrustment to **Mary Help of Christians** this week as we begin to slowly emerge from these times, especially holding the vulnerable in our hearts.
