## Fr Dominic's Gospel Message:

Oct 20/21 and Oct 27/28.

You do not inherit or earn eternal life. Instead, if you are predisposed to it, if you are open to it, then you can receive it as a gift. This is God's gift of himself to us First given o humanity in the person of Jesus, the incarnate word, and then through the sacramental life of His Church. The rich man's wealth is no guarantee of him receiving eternal life. Even the disciples do not actually earn eternal life. The spread of the Gospel though would seem to be what allows the disciples to have riches in heaven. This is really all about discipleship and the mercy of God, because it is through the mercy of God that we can be saved and become true disciples. The life that the disciples live is far apart from the life of the rich man and it is unmistakably the case that the apostles are the real people who have wealth in heaven Jesus is asking the rich man to follow him, but what he is really saying is, 'sell everything and come and 'be' with me' (meaning, come and live with me). Jesus is the true treasure and the only thing that is eternal, and the very thing that Solomon was praying for in the first reading.
