### Commitment Masses

Students and parents must attend one of the weekend Masses at either St Monica's Church (5pm Saturday or 10am Sunday) or St Michael's Church (8am or 5.30pm Sunday) on one of the dates listed below to make their commitment for the sacrament:

There will be no additional Commitment Masses beyond these dates.

Purchasing a stole is optional - it is not compulsory. If you wish to purchase a stole, please make a payment of \$20 through the Qkr! App when you are registering your child for the Sacrament. The stoles will be delivered to the Schools and the School of Religion in the first two weeks of August.

**The Sacrament of Reconciliation** will be celebrated on 8, 9 & 10 November, 2022 - Registrations will open on 19 September 2022.
