Parish Sacramental Program 2023

If your child is in years 4, 5 or 6 in 2023 and they are baptised, this may be a Sacramental year. Sacrament of First Eucharist will be celebrated on 17 and 18 June 2023 across all four parish Masses. Registrations open on Monday 3 April 2023 and will close by Friday 28 April 2023. Registration for the Sacrament must be made via the Our Lady of Perpetual Help Qkr! App (NOT the school app). No late registrations will be accepted after the closing date. Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated on 5, 6, 7 September 2023. Sacrament of Reconciliation will be celebrated in term 1, 2024. School of Religion – Sacrament dates and registration are the same as St Michael's and St Monica's Schools candidates (see above). Classes are held on Tuesdays from 6-7pm in the meeting room in St Monica's Church. Sacrament of First Eucharist - Classes for the Sacrament of First Eucharist will be held on 9,16, 23, 30 May and 6 June 2023 in the meeting room at St Monica's Church, Evatt from 6-7 pm. Archbishop Prowse was recently in Rome representing the Australian Church at a conference on Laity and family Life. Pope Francis attended the conference and gave a challenging address. Here is the first paragraph. For those who wish, copies of the full address are available at the church doors.

"You have come here from various countries to reflect on the shared responsibility of pastors and lay faithful in the Church. The title of your Conference speaks of a "call" to "move forward together", thus setting the subject within the broader context of synodality. The path that God is indicating to the Church is precisely that of a more intense and concrete experience of communion and journeying together. He asks the Church to leave behind ways of acting separately, on parallel tracks that never meet. Clergy separated from laity, consecrated persons from clergy and the faithful; the intellectual faith of certain elites separated from the faith of ordinary people; the Roman Curia from the particular Churches, bishops from priests; young people from the elderly, spouses and families disengaged from the life of the communities, charismatic movements separated from parishes, and so forth. This is the worst temptation at the present moment. The Church still has a long way to go to live as a body, as a true people united by the same faith in Christ the Saviour, enlivened by the same Spirit of holiness and directed to the same mission of proclaiming the merciful love of God
