Outcome of St Monica's Vinnies Appeal-Solomon Islands

As a result of the generosity of parishioners, we raised \$3,966 over the last two weekends for the work of St Theresa Vinnies group in Takwa, Solomon Islands. This is an amazing result and a testament to the willingness of our parishioners to assist those much worse off than ourselves. St Theresa Vinnies members are thrilled with this outcome and are now working to decide the best way to use these funds for their highest priority areas of need: education scholarships; medical supplies for the village clinic; establishment of a small piggery; and expansion of the stock in the Vinnies store. We will provide periodic updates during 2022 on the implementation of these projects. Thank you.

Vinnies Christmas Appeal - St Monica's, 18/19 December

We apologise that the delays with re-opening due to Covid mean this appeal is so soon after our recent Twinning Appeal.

This year's Christmas Appeal is focusing on homelessness. Over the last 18 months we have seen a substantial increase in homelessness in the community we support - Melba, Spence, Evatt and McKellar. The examples in recent weeks include: a man with a mental illness who moves from one friend's house to another couch surfing; a young mother who has recently given birth and fortunately been allocated government housing after an extended period of homelessness; and a family whose breadwinner was injured and lost employment and has been living in a car. Much of this homelessness remains hidden from the wider community. Vinnies has multiple programs to assist people at risk of homelessness or actually homeless and living 'rough' on the streets. We would be grateful for any assistance you can provide. Thank you again.
