#### Update from the Parish Finance Committee: One Collection Arrangements due to Covid-19 Protocols

The PFC would firstly like to thank the parish for its support during this year and secondly, give an update on how things are going with the implementation of one collection. In the past, the First Collection was given to the Central Presbytery Fund to cover the living allowances for current and retired priests throughout the Archdiocese. The Second Collection was for the mission and maintenance of the parish.

**With the simplified One Collection**, 70% remains with the parish and 30% is given to the Central Presbytery Fund. Whilst our income has dropped a little, we have also made some cuts in other areas to compensate. We're happy to report that our finances remain healthy under this arrangement. Your support of the new norm of One Collection is appreciated.
