Vinnies Christmas Appeal - St Monica's, 18/19 December

We apologise that the delays with re-opening due to Covid mean this appeal is so soon after our recent Twinning Appeal. This year's Christmas Appeal is focusing on homelessness. Over the last 18 months we have seen a substantial increase in homelessness in the community we support - Melba, Spence, Evatt and McKellar. The examples in recent weeks include: a man with a mental illness who moves from one friend's house to another couch surfing; a young mother who has recently given birth and fortunately been allocated government housing after an extended period of homelessness; and a family whose breadwinner was injured and lost employment and has been living in a car. Much of this homelessness remains hidden from the wider community. Vinnies has multiple programs to assist people at risk of homelessness or actually homeless and living 'rough' on the streets. We would be grateful for any assistance you can provide. Thank you again.
