No headlines, nothing in the general media, what are the delegates doing?

The delegates have spent much of the time praying and reflecting, guided by Pope Francis.
From 9th October to 14th, the delegates reflected on

From 9st October to 14st, the delegates reflected on Communion in the Church, not Holy Communion, but the unity in the church, how unity can embrace diversity. From 16th to 21st they will be looking at the Mission of the Church – the mission of every Catholic, using their gifts and talents to serve and evangelise. From 23rd to 29th the delegates will pray and reflect on Participation in the Church – how the uniqueness of every Catholic can contribute to a Church where everyone can know they belong and serve. The First session of the Synod will conclude on 29th October, to resume for its second session in October 24th. I'm sure Pope Francis will report back to us over the coming months.
