# Archdiocesan Protocols as of 13 January 2022

Facemasks are mandatory in churches.

The 2sqm per person rule applies for inside the church. Congregational singing is not permitted. Holy Communion may be received in the hand only.

### **Collection Plate for Weekend Masses**

Cash collections have been reinstated. The collection plate will be passed around at Masses.

### Parish Sacramental Program 2022 If you have a child in years 3, 4 or 6 in 2022, this will be a Sacramental year.

This applies also if your child is in year 5 and he/she has previously missed the sacraments of Reconciliation and/or First Eucharist.

A Parish Sacramental Program Information Evening will be held on Thursday 17 February 2022 at 6pm for years 3-6 families.

First Eucharist will be celebrated in term 2, 2022. Confirmation will be celebrated in term 3, 2022. Reconciliation will be celebrated in term 4, 2022.

# Vinnies Christmas Appeal – St Monica's –Use of Funds

As we mentioned in recent parish bulletins, parishioners and the St Monica's school together donated \$7346 to our Christmas Appeal in December. This was a fantastic outcome. We used some of this money to help us prepare and deliver Christmas hampers and toys to 35 families (to a value of \$3300). We also drew on these funds to provide emergency support in the new year to a number of families facing the risk of homelessness, including one family 'couch surfing' at the home of friends. The remainder of the funds were directed to support some of the Vinnies programs which help homeless members of our community, including Samaritan House which provides short term crisis accommodation for men; and the Family Services Program which provides outreach support services to families at risk of or experiencing homelessness and assists them to access affordable housing. Thanks again for your generosity.
