#### Parish Sacramental Program 2023

Sacrament of First Eucharist will be celebrated across all four parish Masses.

Registrations **open on Monday 3 April 2023** and will close by Friday 28 April 2023.Registration for the Sacrament <u>must</u> be made via the Our Lady of Perpetual Help Qkr! App (**NOT** the school app). If you are registering more than 1 child you will need to fully complete and pay for each separate registration. <u>No late registrations</u> will be accepted after the closing date.

Students and parents must attend one of the weekend Masses at either St Monica's Church (5pm Saturday or 10am Sunday) or St Michael's Church (8am or 5:30pm Sunday) on one of the dates listed below to make their commitment for the Sacrament.

There will be no additional commitment masses beyond these dates.

## Purchasing a stole for First Eucharist

Purchasing a stole is optional and is not compulsory (you can borrow one on the day). If you wish to purchase a stole, please make a payment of \$20 through Qkr! With the registration and the stole will be delivered to the schools and the School of Religion (SOR).

School of Religion – Sacrament dates and registration are the same as St Michael's and St Monica's School candidates (see above). Sacrament of First Eucharist - Classes for this sacrament will be held on 9,16, 23, 30 May and 6 June 2023 in the meeting room at St Monica's Church, Evatt from 6-7 pm.

Sacrament of Confirmation will be celebrated on 5,6, 7 September 2023. Sacrament of Reconciliation will be celebrated in 2024.

## Pope Francis - Wednesday 22nd March

Dear brothers and sisters: In our continuing catechesis on missionary zeal, we now consider the teaching of Saint Paul VI in his Apostolic Exhoration Evangelii Nuntiandi, on evangelisation in the modern world. Pope Paul insisted that evangelisation is primarily a personal witness to the Gospel and its saving truth. For this reason, he stressed the importance, in all the baptised, of a living faith in the triune God, manifested in a life of holiness fully consistent with the message we proclaim. Holiness of life, grounded in the gift of the Holy Spirit received in baptism, is the source of our zeal to share with others the treasure of new life and hope that is ours. Pope Paul went on to say that the Church not only evangelises, but is herself evangelised, that is, constantly called to conversion and interior renewal in the Spirit. A Church that evangelises is entirely turned to God, the source of our salvation, and, at the same time, entirely engaged in a creative dialogue with the world, cooperating with the Lord's gracious plan for the unity and peace of our human family.
