Density limits are terminated. All pews in the church are now available. QR Check-In is terminated. Masks are no longer mandatory for liturgical and parochial gatherings (beginning Friday 25 February). Choirs and singing recommence. Reception of Holy Communion: Sacred Host only, not the Precious Blood (to be reviewed in the coming months). Communion in the hand and on the tongue (reinstated).
