Through an understanding of the Billings charting system, it is hoped that some of the myths surrounding fertility and the tracking of natural observations are exposed and debunked. A visual "map" of a female cycle can be of enormous benefit to someone who is trying to conceive a baby. It also helps women in all stages of the continuum, especially young, single women, to understand their fertility. So many things can impact a cycle and of course with such busy lifestyles, cycles are not always numerically regular.
