Just outside the gates of his big house was a poor man. Lazarus had no home. He had nothing but what he was wearing. He was hungry but had no food.

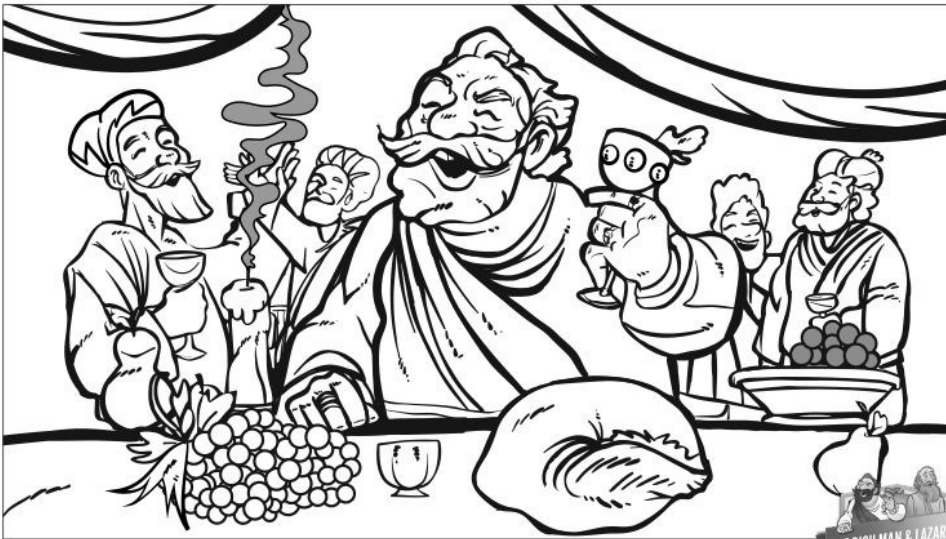
The rich man was so busy enjoying his life and feasting with his rich friends that he did not even think about poor Lazarus. He certainly did nothing to help him.
