Booking System for Saturday Vigil and Sunday Masses

Before you enter the church, an attendant will tick off your name. When the permitted number of people has been reached, the church door will be closed. Please make use of the hand sanitiser upon entering and leaving the church.

Archdiocesan Protocols Regarding CoronaVirus as of 19 June 2020

Masses are to be celebrated with **no more than 100 people**, respecting the 4sqm per person rule (including priest and those involved in liturgical ministries).

- Communion in the hand only.
- Sacred Host, not the Precious Blood, to be offered.
- No touching at the sign of peace.
- No collection plates are to be used, but money/envelopes placed at collection points.

The 4sqm per person rule applies to seating, standing, during the Communion Procession and during the movement to place money and envelopes at the collection points.

Hygiene practices are as follows:

Sanitisation of hands before entering the church
Wiping down of pews and common areas at conclusion of Mass
Priest and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion to purify hands with sanitiser before and after offering Holy Communion.
Limit the use of books. Ensure they are cleansed between use.

Register for Contact Tracing

The register of people upon entering the church should include name, phone number or email and be kept in a safe place (respecting privacy laws) for 28 days, for the chief medical officer.

Funerals, Weddings, Baptisms and Penance (First and Second Rite) may take place with no more than 100 people, respecting the 4sqm per person rule.
