Updated Protocols Regarding CoronaVirus as of 25 March

Churches are to be closed 24 hours each day.

There are to be no catechetical, spiritual or social gatherings in parishes.

No public Masses are to be celebrated until further notice.

No Holy Communion is to be given to sick persons in hospitals, aged care homes or private homes until further notice.

Funerals and Weddings

Graveside funerals only are allowed, with a maximum of ten people, including the celebrant. Weddings are to be conducted outside the sacred space only, with a maximum of 5 people, including the celebrant.

Baptism

Baptisms are suspended until further notice, including RCIA candidates, except in the case of emergency.

Penance

The First Rite of Penance should be conducted in an open space, with priest and penitent observing 1.5 metre spacing. The Second Rite of Penance is suspended until further notice.
