Archdiocesan Protocols Regarding Covid 19

As of 28 June 2021, some changes have come into effect. The wearing of a mask is now mandatory for all Masses, weddings, funerals, liturgies and gatherings. The priest and Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion must wear a mask when distributing the Sacred Host. No congregational singing is permitted. The use of the CBR App is mandatory for checking in however the physical register is reasonable for those unable to use the App. Families can sit together but the 2m² rule applies otherwise. The full protocols have been posted to the main door of the church and have been uploaded to the parish website. Please be aware of these current protocols.
